New in this Release

This section lists the enhancements to IDOL Data Admin version 11.5.0.

- You can now configure IDOL Data Admin to connect to multiple QMS clusters, by creating an `additionalIdolConfigurations.json` file in your configuration directory. This file contains a section for each QMS group, which must contain the details of the QMS, Agentstore, and Statistics Server components. You can optionally also specify a Content and View component configuration for the QMS groups. By default, it shares the Content and View configuration from the main configuration file.
- IDOL Data Admin now prompts for confirmation before you can delete a document.
- IDOL Data Admin now logs the document database, `AUTN_IDENTIFIER`, and `AUTN_GROUP` if present when you delete a document.

Resolved Issues

This section lists the resolved issues in IDOL Data Admin version 11.5.0.

- The `AnswerBankStatisticsCacheImpl` operation sometimes generated errors in the logs because it attempted to contact Answer Server when it was not enabled.
- In the Mozilla Firefox Web browser, on the Assign unanswered question to QEC page in Answer Bank, the Create Answer button could overlap the Processed Questions box.
- Answer Bank could return an error when attempting to view Incoming Questions when there were no questions available.
- Quotation marks in highlighted text were sometimes double-escaped.
- When requesting a document to view, IDOL Data Admin did not include a database filter, which could result in it displaying the wrong document if there are multiple databases containing documents with the same reference. This behavior also meant that the audit log contained null values for the database.
- After changing the schedule of a promotion, the Schedule page did not update, and the button remained in a scheduling state.
- IDOL Data Admin failed to update pin-to-position promotions with new documents, and did not log an error.

The following issues were resolved in IDOL Data Admin version 11.4.1.

- In certain circumstances, it was possible to delete the current user from IDOL Data Admin. Server-side validation has now been improved to return an error if the logged-in user attempts to delete their own account.
- IDOL Data Admin did not escape user names in the user delete dialog box. User names are now escaped to prevent the Web browser from running valid javascript contained in a user name.

Notes

These notes provide extra information about installing and using IDOL Data Admin.

- The IDOL Data Admin installer now includes the Statistics Server configuration file. This file was previously included only in the ZIP installation package.
